#### Committee meeting

Minutes agreed from the last meeting.

TK and AH removed KM from the bank account and completed online registration for the bank account for AH.

Invoices: SJL and Cheeky Monkeys have paid. The Hub, Redrose and Little Explorers yet to pay for the adverts placed in the Christmas Fair Programme. TK sent overdue invoices today. Redrose said they will pay ASAP.

- Daily Mile Track TK had a meeting with DCM on 29/01/19 to quote for the track. TK showed the committee the samples in brown and green. Total cost of the works around £12.5k to 13.3k not including VAT. TK suggested school should order. TK has emailed Jennifer back to say they are competitive but no decision has been made yet.
- Worship area TK had a meeting with IP Jones Fencing on 29/01/19 to discuss the jet washing, benches and entranceway for the worship area. The committee looked at the photos of the ideas of structures from school. TK has also contacted reclamation yards to see if they have anything and one got back. TK has been in touch with the Church of England Head Office to see if they can help. TK has contacted a marble manufacturer in China for the centerpiece. Total cost approx £980 including shipping to the UK. Children to write a letter to Avant garden centre to see if they can help design the greenery. The committee suggested the possibility of a competition to get the children to design it or the possibility of getting the church involved.

- Residential Up to last week 45 people had signed up. TK has emailed MG to see if he could have a
  meeting with the children in Year 5 to explain about the trip. He had the meeting on Thursday.
  Deposit was supposed to be paid by this week. No news on coach costs. This could come out of the
  Summer Fair money.
